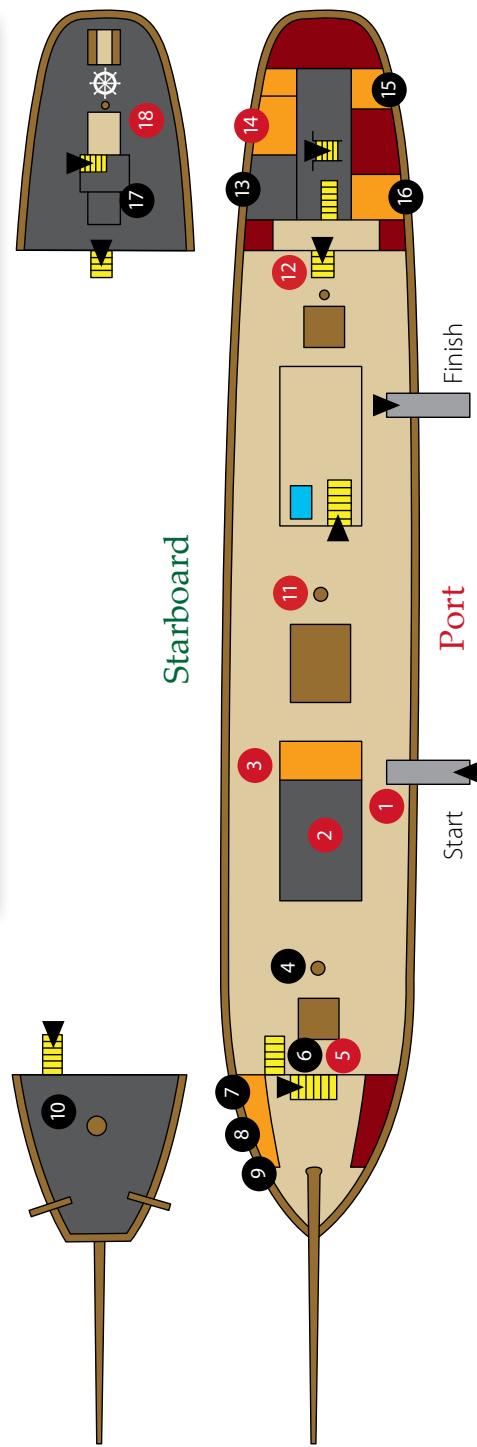




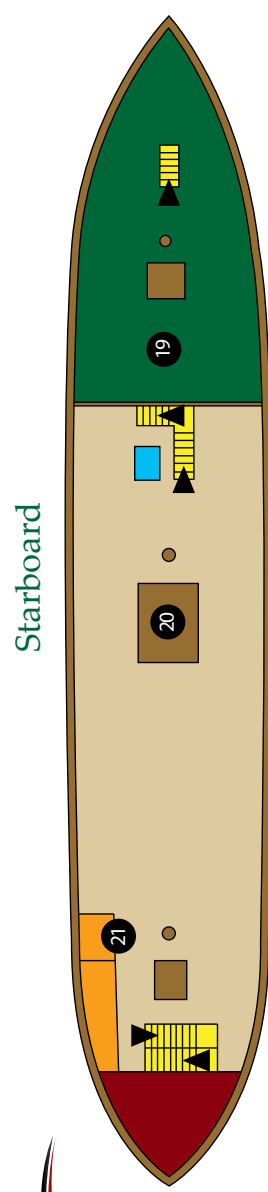
Glenlee deck plan

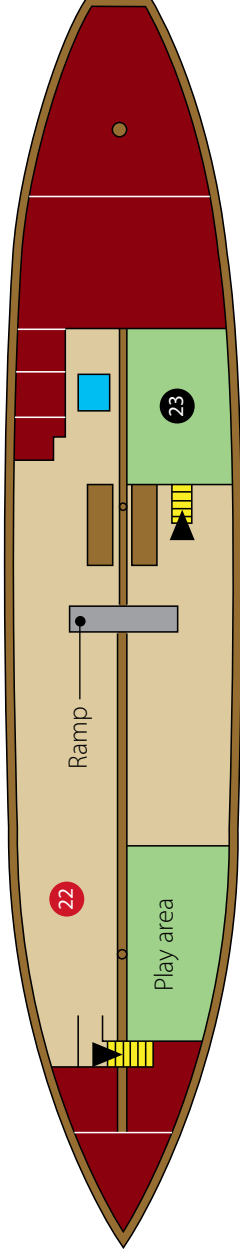

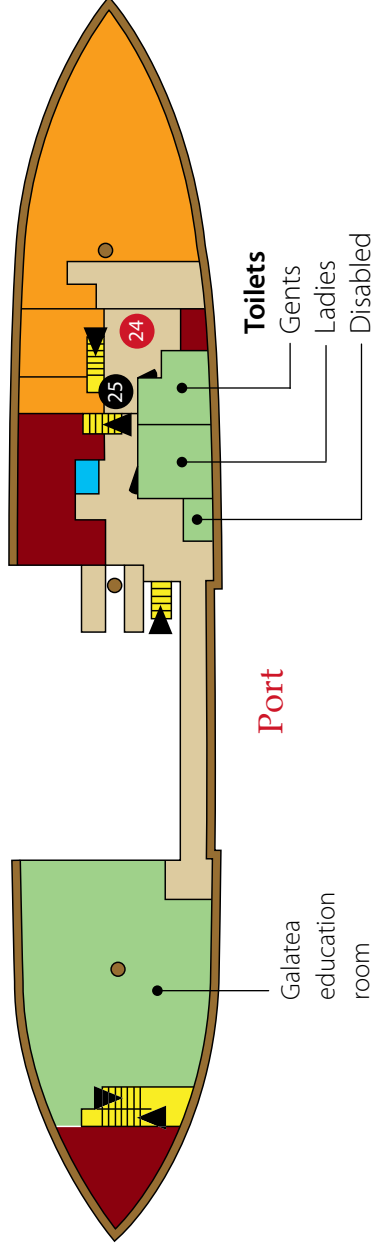
