



Jock the Cat and the Pirate Mice

Curriculum for Excellence Experience and Outcomes

N1-P1

Students learn about the adventures of Jock, our ship's cat, as he saves *Glenlee* from troublesome pirate mice. Activities include dressing-up, role play and pirate songs. Students will then become mini-rodent inspectors as they take part in a teacher-led mouse hunt around the ship and finish in the cargo hold interactive play area.
