

Mermaids and Sea Creatures

Curriculum for Excellence Experience and Outcomes

N1-P1

Students join a costumed Sailor Sally to hear about her adventures on the high seas and encounters with the creatures that live in them, followed by an opportunity to make their own mermaid or merman. Activities include storytelling, role play, object handling, songs and crafts. Students will then explore the ship in a teacher-led mouse hunt searching for all the hidden rats.
