Berthed alongside the Riverside Museum, the Ship operates as a historic vessel/visitor attraction, welcoming over 200,000 visitors per year, giving locals and tourists an insight into life aboard a sailing ship. This is a great opportunity for a motivated individual to join our well-established maintenance team.

Full-time position with training.

Candidates must be physically fit, have good customer service skills (people skills, friendly) and have excellent DIY skills, painting, woodworking etc. The successful candidate will use traditional and modern techniques within the public environment maintaining the Tall Ship which involves working extensively outdoors. The ability to work at height would be advantageous.

The crew person will work primarily on the Sv Glenlee (The Tall Ship) in all aspects of maintaining a traditional sailing ship, this will include caulking the deck, working aloft in the rigging, woodworking, steelwork, and painting. Training in traditional ship keeping skills will be provided.

Training offered:

- Full-time with on-the-job training in traditional maritime skills.
- Rope access training: Irata level 1
- Powerboat training: Level 2
- Customer service training: NVQ

Once the trainee has achieved competence within the crew/VST role, additional training would be considered in a specialisation (woodworking/metalwork/boatbuilding)
