The Tall Ship *Glenlee* is one of Glasgow's most unique attractions and a unique part of the UK's maritime heritage. Glenlee welcomes over 200,000 visitors annually, providing a unique insight into life aboard and the construction of one of the few remaining Clydebuilt steel sailing ships. The ship is owned by Clyde Maritime Trust and operated as a visitor attraction and museum. Glenlee is berthed behind the Riverside Museum.

Post Detail.

Candidates must be physically fit, enthusiastic and comfortable working at height and outdoors.

Successful candidates will use traditional and modern techniques candidates to maintain the Glenlee. Typical tasks may include: working aloft, caulking the deck, wood and steel work and painting.

The role has a public facing component and applicants should be able and prepared to engage with visitors to the ship.

The crew form a part of the team that supports Glenlee and teamwork and the ability to contribute will be valued

Training is part of the role and an individual training plan for any successful applicant will be part of development. This will likely include rope access training (IRATA), marine and maritime skills and customer service training.
